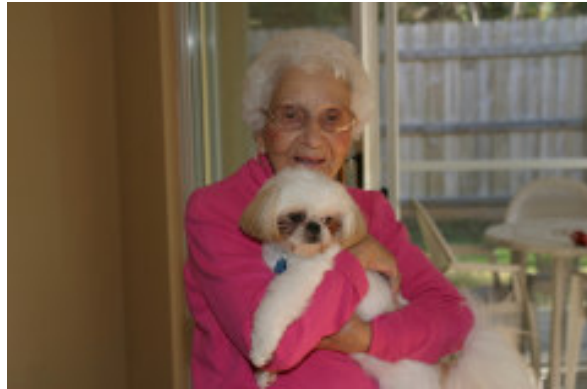

What will happen to your pets if they outlive you? Assuming that your children or neighbor will take your pet is not always the best thing for the pet.



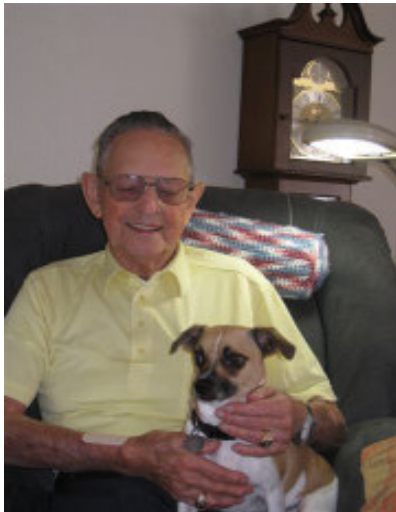
WAGS TO RICHES CAN HELP

FACTORS TO CONSIDER

In considering a distribution amount, you should consider factors such as your past spending history regarding your pet's care, the age and health of your pet and also that pets tend to require more expensive veterinarian care when they get older.

This amount will help with the care of your pet while Wags searches for the best possible home and sometimes that can take awhile.

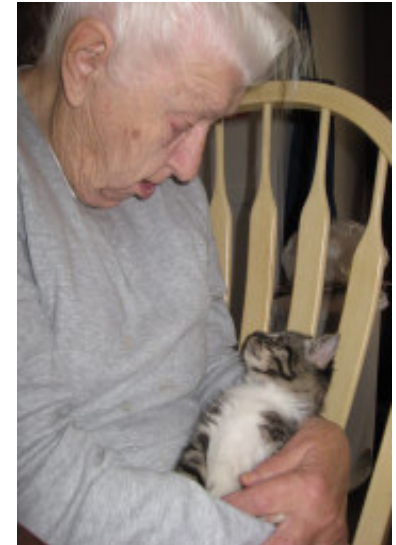
Not everyone can adopt. Adoptions can take time and there is a strict adoption process.

We want to make sure that the family that we choose for your pet will be somebody that you would have approved of and we want your pet(s) to be happy too.

WHAT WE NEED TO KNOW ABOUT YOUR PET

We also encourage you to communicate with Wags, both verbally and in writing, what we need to know to take good care of your pet.

Helpful things include your pet's name and nicknames, types of food, name and contact information of your veterinarian, health history and concerns, any special treats and toys, any additional services (massage, etc.) feeding times, spots where your pet likes to be petted or other information you think we should know.



Also, anything we should know that causes your pet concern, such as bathing, toe nail clipping, trimmers, kids, cats or dogs. Sometimes pets prefer women more than men or vice-versa.
